I Concentration of market participants in summary procedure is approved created by acquisition of control by company "Ukrainian Pharmaceutical Holdings" from Ukraine with registered head-office at Shevchenka bilv., Donecka oblast, Doneck, 83052. set up and organized in line with laws of Ukraine, under ID 36381 over company A'STA LIMITED with registered head-office at 3-V, Skladska Street, Donecka oblast, Doneck 83059, Ukraine, set up and organized in line with laws of Ukraine, ID 36253841 resulting from purchase of 100% of share in target company by applicant of concentration, by which Ukrainian Pharmaceutical Holding became sole holder of company A'STA LIMITED.

II It is established that the payment in the amount of EUR 25.000 was effected, in prescribed time period, to the foreign currency account of Commission for Protection of Competition maintained with National Bank of Serbia, representing corresponding level of compensation referred to in Article 2, paragraph 1, item 6, of the Tariff on the level of compensation for activities within the competency of the Commission for Protection of Competition.
