On June 6, 2012 President of the Commission for Protection of Competition pursuant to Article 37, paragraph 2 of the Law on Protection of Competition ("Official Journal of the RS", no. 51/09) and Article 2, item 6, of the Tariff on the level of compensation for activities within the competency of Commission for Protection of Competition ("Official Journal of the RS", no. 49/2011) deciding under notification of concentration submitted through proxy – lawyer Mr. Rastko Petakovic, from law-office Karanovic & Nikolic, located at Resavska 23, Beograd, by company Watson Pharma S.a.r.l. with registered head-office at 46 A, Avenue J.F. Kennedy, L-1855 the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg, issued a following

DECISION

I Concentration of market participants is approved in summary procedure created by acquisition of control on the part of company Watson Pharma S.a.r.l. with registered head-office at 46 A, Avenue J.F.Kennedy, L-1855, the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg, ref. no. 149.490, over companies Actavis Pharma Holding 4 ehf. with registered head-office at Reykjavikurvegi 76-78, 220 Hafnarfjordur, Island, reference no. 6504070910, company Actavis S.a.r.l. with registered head-office at 6C, Rue Gabriel Lippmann, L 5365 Munsbach Luxembourg, ref. no. B154827, and company Actavis Inc. with registered head-office at 874 Walker Road, Suite C Dover, Delaware 19904, U.S.A., ref. no. B154827, as a result of takeover, on the grounds of Agreement on Purchase and Sales, of 100% of share in each of these companies from current owners of those share, whereby company established control over entire Actavis Group.

II It is established that applicant in relevant concentration effected payment on time, of EUR 25.000, to the foreign currency account of the Commission for Protection of Competition maintained with National Bank of Serbia, ref. no. 6/0-02-350/2012, representing corresponding level of compensation for issuance of decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure referred to in Article 2, paragraph 1, item 6, of the Tariff on the level of compensation for activities within the competency of the Commission for Protection of Competition.
