Pursuant to Article 37(2) of the Law on Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the RS”, number 51/09 and 95/13), Article 192(1) of the Law on General Administrative Procedure (“Official Gazette of the FRY”, number 33/97, 31/01 and “Official Gazette of the RS”, number 30/10), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensation for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the RS”, number 49/11), deciding under the notification on concentration entered under number 6/0-02-822/2016-1, submitted on December 2, 2016, by company Erste Card Club Ltd., with registered seat at the address 5 Praška Street, Zagreb, Croatia, company registration number 03289737, PIB 85941596441, via plenipotentiary attorney Đura Otašević and other attorneys from the Law office NKO Partners, with registered seat at the address 11 Njegoševa Street, Belgrade, on January 16, 2017, the President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

### **DECISION<sup>1</sup>**

**I** Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquisition of direct control on the part of company Erste Card Club Ltd., with registered seat at the address 5 Praška Street, Zagreb, Croatia, company registration number 03289737, over Diners Club International Belgrade Ltd. Belgrade, with registered seat at the address 26 Baba Višnjina Street, Vračar, Belgrade, Serbia, company registration number 06065210, by acquiring 100% share of this company, and indirect control over its subsidiary company DC Travel Ltd., with registered seat at the address 26 Baba Višnjina Street, Vračar, Belgrade, Serbia, company registration number 17378724.

**II IT IS ESTABLISHED** that the applicant of notification has executed the payment in the amount of EUR 24,962.00 (in words: twenty-four thousand, nine hundred sixty-two Euro), and additional payment in the amount of EUR 38 (in words: thirty-eight Euro) to the foreign-currency account of the Commission for Protection of Competition maintained with the National Bank of Serbia, which in total represents determined amount of the fee as compensation for issuing decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure.
