Pursuant to Article 37(2) of the Law on Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the RS”, number 51/09 and 95/13), Article 192(1) of the Law on General Administrative Procedure (“Official Gazette of the FRY”, number 33/97, 31/01 and “Official Gazette of the RS”, number 30/10), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensation for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the RS”, number 49/11), deciding under the notification on concentration entered under number 6/0-02-839/2016-1 submitted on December 7, 2016 by Robert Bosch GmbH company, with registered seat at the address Robert-Bosch-Platz 1, 70839 Gerlingen-Schillerhöhe, Germany, via plenipotentiary Srđana Petronijević, attorney from the Law office Moravčević, Vojnović and Partners, with registered seat at the address 15 Dobračina Street, Belgrade, on January 5, 2017, the President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

DECISION¹

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquisition of indirect control on the part of Robert Bosch GmbH company, with registered seat at the address Robert-Bosch-Platz 1, 70839 Gerlingen-Schillerhöhe, Germany, company registration number HRB 14000, via its subsidiary company Bosch Sicherheitssysteme GmbH, with registered seat at the address P.O. Box 11 11, D-85626 Grasbrunn, Germany, company registration number HRB 23118, over targeted operations encompassing sales and customer support of Sony Corporation’s System of video-surveillance, with registered seat at the address 7-1 Konan 1-Chome, Minato-ku, Tokyo 108-0075, Japan, on all markets except in Japan.

II IT IS ESTABLISHED that the applicant of notification has executed the payment in the amount of RSD 3,086,280.00 (in words: three million, eighty-six thousand, two hundred eighty Dinars), to the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition maintained with the Treasury Administration of the Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Serbia, which represents determined amount of the fee as compensation for issuing decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure.
