Pursuant to Article 37(2) of the Law on Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the RS”, nos. 51/09 and 95/13), Article 192(1) of the Law on General Administrative Procedure (“Official Gazette of the FRY”, nos. 33/97, 31/01 and “Official Gazette of the RS”, no. 30/10), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensation for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the RS”, no. 49/11), deciding under the Notification on concentration entered under number 6/0-02-601/2016-1, submitted on August 19, 2016, by company „Azelis“ PLC, represented by plenipotentiary Bojana Miljanović and other attorneys from the Law office “Karanović and Nikolić” from Belgrade, 23 Resavska Street, Belgrade, on September 6, 2016, President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquiring direct individual control on the part of company „Azelis“ PLC, founded in accordance with the legislation of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg, with registered seat at the address 19, rue Gabriel Lippmann, L-5365 Munsbach, Grand Duchy of Luxembourg, registered in the Luxembourg Trade and Companies Register under company and fiscal registration number B 129324, over company „Ametech“ LLC, founded and operating in accordance with the legislation of Italy, with registered seat at the address Via Don N. Fedeli 3, 20020 Arese (MI), Italy, registered in the Trade and Companies Register of Milano under company and fiscal registration number 02948890963, in manner where „Azelis“ PLC will acquire 100% of ownership interest in „Ametech“ LLC.

II IT IS ESTABLISHED that the applicant of Notification has executed payment in the amount of EUR 24,936.00 (in words: twenty-four thousand, nine hundred thirty-six Euro) to the foreign-currency account of the Commission for Protection of Competition maintained with the National Bank of Serbia, and RSD 7,884.63 (in words: seven thousand, eight hundred eighty-four and sixty-three hundredths Dinars) to the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition maintained with the Treasury Administration of the Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Serbia, reference number 6/0-02-601/2016-1, which in total represents determined amount of the fee as compensation for issuing decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure.
