Pursuant to Article 37(2) of the Law on Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the RS”, nos. 51/09 and 95/13), Article 192(1) of the Law on General Administrative Procedure (“Official Gazette of the FRY”, nos. 33/97, 31/01 and “Official Gazette of the RS”, no. 30/10), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensation for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the RS”, no. 49/11), deciding under the notification on concentration entered under number 6/0-02-371/2016-1 of April 28, 2016, submitted by company “Hemofarm” JSC Vršac, with registered seat at the address bb Beogradski put Street, Vršac, Republic of Serbia, via plenipotentiary attorney Dragan Gajin from the Law office “Karanović and Nikolić” from Belgrade, 23 Resavska Street, on June 1, 2016, President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquisition on the part of company “Hemofarm” JSC Vršac, with registered seat at the address bb Beogradski put Street, Vršac, Republic of Serbia, company registration number 08010536, of non-controlling interests in company „Inter Pharma“ LLC Subotica, with registered seat at the address 14 Matije Gubca Street, Subotica, Republic of Serbia, company registration number 20127791, in manner where the acquirer of non-controlling interests, as per associated veto rights, partakes in performing of joint control over company „Inter Pharma“ LLC Subotica, with its previous members.

II IT IS ESTABLISHED that company “Hemofarm” JSC Vršac, has fully performed against its obligation related to paying determined amount of the fee as compensation for issuing this decision, by paying amount of RSD 3,064,537.50 (in words: three million, sixty-four thousand, five hundred thirty-seven and five tenths Dinars) to the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition maintained with the National Bank of Serbia, which represents determined Dinar-currency amount of the fee as compensation for issuing decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure.
