Pursuant to Article 37(2) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), Article 192(1) of the Law on General Administrative Procedure (Official Gazette of the FRY 33/97 and 31/01, and Official Gazette of the RS 30/10), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/2011), deciding under the notification on concentration entered under number 6/0-02-729/2015-1 of September 30, 2015 submitted by company Messer Hungarogáz Kft, founded in accordance with the legislation of Hungary, company registration number 01-09-725341, with registered seat at the address Váci út 117, Budapest, Hungary, via attorney at law Nikola B. Poznanović from the Law Office of Janković Popović Mitić, 6 Vladimira Popovića St., Belgrade, on October 28, 2015, President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquisition of direct control on the part of company Messer Hungarogáz Kft, founded in accordance with the legislation of Hungary, company registration number 01-09-725341, with registered seat at the address Váci út 117, Budapest, Hungary, over company Air Liquide Hungary Ipari Gáztermelő Kft, founded in accordance with the legislation of Hungary, company registration number 01-09-685663, with registered seat at the address Krisztina krt. 39/b, H-1013, Budapest, Hungary (Target company), created by acquiring 100% of shares in the target company.

II IT IS ESTABLISHED that the applicant of notification on concentration has within the stipulated deadline executed payment in the amount of EUR 25,000.00 (in words: twenty-five thousand and 00/100 euro) to the foreign-currency account of the Commission for Protection of Competition maintained with the National Bank of Serbia, which represents determined amount of the fee as compensation for issuing decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure from Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensation for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition.
