Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), deciding under the Notification of concentration entered under number 6/0-02-527/2018-1 of July 12, 2018, submitted by company AsterFarm d.o.o. Beograd-Novı Beograd, with registered seat at the address 14/5 Đorđa Stanojevića St., Belgrade-New Belgrade, Republic of Serbia, via procuration holder, attorney at Milica Boškov and others from the Law Office NKO Partners from Belgrade, 11 Njegoševa St., on August 28, 2018, member of the Council of the Commission for Protection of Competition acting upon the authority granted by the Commission President no. 1/0-06-119/2018-2 of January 8, 2018, enacts the following

## **DECISION**

**I** Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquisition of direct individual control on the part of company AsterFarm d.o.o. Beograd-Novı Beograd, with registered seat at the address 14/5 Đorđa Stanojevića St., Belgrade-New Belgrade, Republic of Serbia, registered with the Business Registers Agency under company number 21217328, over Health care facility Pharmacy „Leko-Vita“ Mladenovac, with registered seat at the address 230 Kralja Petra I St., Mladenovac, Republic of Serbia, registered with the Commercial Court in Belgrade, court registry entry no. 5-945-00, company number 17670743, by acquiring 100% of shares.

**II IT IS ESTABLISHED** that the Party has executed payment in the amount of RSD 2,951,275.00 (in words: two million, nine hundred fifty-one thousand, two hundred seventy-five dinars) on August 13, 2018, to the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents a stipulated amount of the fee as compensation for issuing decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure.
