Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), deciding under the notification of concentration entered under number 6/0-02-865/2018-1 of December 5, 2018, submitted by company Petrol društvo za trgovinu naftom i naftnim derivatima d.o.o. Beograd (Rakovica), with registered seat at the address 12v Patrijarha Dimitrija St., Belgrade, via procuration holder, attorney at law Igor Isailović from Belgrade, 16 Balkanska St., on December 21, 2018, the President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquisition of direct control on the part of company Petrol društvo za trgovinu naftom i naftnim derivatima d.o.o. Beograd (Rakovica), with registered seat at the address 12v Patrijarha Dimitrija St., Belgrade, company number 17454404, over a petrol station owned by company „NES PETROL TRADE“ d.o.o. Banja Luka, with registered seat at the address 31 Cara Lazara St., Banja Luka, Bosnia and Hercegovina, company number 57-01-0166-15, located at the address 147 Novosadski put St., Veternik, Novi Sad, cadastral plot no. 3714/1 CM Veternik, pursuant to the Lease Agreement.

II IT IS ESTABLISHED that the Party, company Petrol društvo za trgovinu naftom i naftnim derivatima d.o.o. Beograd (Rakovica), has executed payment in the amount of RSD 2,960,197.50 (in words: two million, nine hundred sixty thousand, one hundred ninety-seven and 50/100 dinars) on December 17, 2018, to the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents an appropriate dinar-currency equivalent value of the fee as compensation for issuing decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure, calculated at the middle exchange rate of the National Bank of Serbia on the day of payment.
