Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), deciding under the notification of concentration entered under number 6/0-02-724/2018-1 of October 12, 2018, submitted by company Summer BidCo B.V., with registered seat at the address Gustav Mahlerlaan 310 C, Floor 4, Unit 3, 1082 ME, Amsterdam, the Netherlands, via procurator holder, attorney at law Tijana Kojović from the Law Office BDK Advokati, 28 Kralja Aleksandra Blvd., Belgrade, on January 14, 2019, the President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

## **DECISION**

**I** Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquisition of indirect control on the part of company BC Partners Holding Limited, with registered seat at the address Heritage Hall Le Marchant Street St Peter Port Guernsey GY1 4HY, Guernsey, company number 29682, via its subsidiary company Summer BidCo B.V., with registered seat at the address Gustav Mahlerlaan 310 C, Floor 4, Unit 3, 1082 ME, Amsterdam, the Netherlands, company number 71716734, over company Adria Topco B.V., with registered seat at the address Overschiestraat 61-5, 1062, Amsterdam, the Netherlands, company number 00002823511, by purchasing 51.77% of shares.

**II IT IS ESTABLISHED** that the Party has executed payment in the amount of RSD 2,956,030.00 (in words: two million, nine hundred fifty-six thousand, thirty and 00/100 dinars) on October 15, 2018, to the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents a stipulated amount of the fee as compensation for issuing decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure.
