Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), deciding under the notification of concentration entered under number 6/0-02-726/2018-1 of October 15, 2018, submitted by company Industrijaimport – Industrijaimpex a.d., with registered seat at the address 3 Svetlane Kane Radenović St., Podgorica, Republic of Montenegro, and natural persons Miomir Nikolić, 5 Njegoševa St., Belgrade, Republic of Serbia, and Lovorka Nikolić, 11 Subotička St., Belgrade, Republic of Serbia, via procuration holder, attorney at law Mladen Vujić from the Law Office BDK Advokati AOD from Belgrade, 28 Kralja Aleksandra Blvd., on January 4, 2019, the President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

## **DECISION**

**I** Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquisition of joint control on the part of company Industrijaimport – Industrijaimpex a.d., company number 4-0000053/019, with registered seat at the address 3 Svetlane Kane Radenović St., Podgorica, Republic of Montenegro, and natural persons Miomir Nikolić, 5 Njegoševa St., Belgrade, Republic of Serbia, and Lovorka Nikolić, 11 Subotička St., Belgrade, Republic of Serbia, over company Farmalogist Holding d.o.o., company number 20306327, with registered seat at the address 25-27 Vojvode Mišića Blvd., Belgrade, Republic of Serbia, by purchasing shares.

**II** **IT IS ESTABLISHED** that the Party, company Industrijaimport – Industrijaimpex a.d., has made payment in the amount of EUR 25,000.00 (in words: twenty-five thousand euro) on December 27, 2018, into the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents a stipulated amount of the fee as compensation for issuing decision on the approval of concentration in summary procedure.
