Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), deciding under the notification of concentration entered under number 6/0-02-255/2019-1 of February 4, 2019, submitted by company Robert Bosch GmbH, with registered seat at the address Robert-Bosch-Platz 1, 70839 Gerlingen-Schillerhöhe, Germany, via procurator holder, attorney at law Srđana Petronijević from the Law Office of Moravčević, Vojnović and Partners, 15 Dobračina St., Belgrade, on February 20, 2019, the President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

## **DECISION**

**I** Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquisition of individual control on the part of company Bosch Service Solutions GmbH, with registered seat at the address Lahnstrasse 34-40, 60326 Frankfurt am Main, Germany, company number HRB 17902, a subsidiary to Robert Bosch GmbH, with registered seat at the address Robert-Bosch-Platz 1, 70839 Gerlingen-Schillerhöhe, Germany, company number HRB 14000, over company Lawa Solutions GmbH, with registered seat at the address Zu den Muhlen 19, 35390 Giesen, Germany, company number HRB 8831.

**II IT IS ESTABLISHED** that the Party, company Robert Bosch GmbH, with registered seat at the address Robert-Bosch-Platz 1, 70839 Gerlingen-Schillerhöhe, Germany, has made payment in full as compensation for issuing this decision in the amount of RSD 2,955,142.50 (in words: two million, nine hundred fifty-five thousand, one hundred forty-two and 50/100 dinars) on February 12, 2019, into the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition.
