Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), deciding under the merger notification entered under number 6/0-02-410/2019-1 of April 16, 2019, jointly submitted by companies Mirova S.A., with registered seat at the address 59 avenue Pierre Mendès-France, 75013 Paris, France, and Predica Prévoyance Dialogue du Crédit Agricole S.A., with registered seat at the address 50-56 rue de la Procession, 75015, Paris, France, via procuration holder, attorney at law Srđan Dabetić from the Law Office of Karanović and Partners from Belgrade, 23 Resavska St., on May 22, 2019, the President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquisition of joint control on the part of companies Mirova S.A., company number 394 648 216, with registered seat at the address 59 avenue Pierre Mendès-France, 75013 Paris, France, and Predica Prévoyance Dialogue du Crédit Agricole S.A., company number 334 028 123, with registered seat at the address 50-56 rue de la Procession, 75015, Paris, France, over company Infra Foch Topco S.A.S., company number 801 364 332, with registered seat at the address Tour Voltaire, 1 places des Degrés, 92800 Puteaux, France, created by purchasing shares in the target company.

II IT IS ESTABLISHED that the party, company Predica Prevoyance Dialogue du Credit Agricole SA, company number 334 028 123, has made payment in the amount of EUR 24,936.00 (in words: twenty-four thousand nine hundred thirty-six euro) on April 30, 2019, and the amount of RSD 7,551.48 (in words: seven thousand five hundred fifty-one and 48/100 dinars) on May 8, 2019, into the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents a stipulated amount of the fee as compensation for issuing decision on the approval of concentration in summary procedure.
