Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), deciding in proceedings initiated upon receipt of a merger notification registered before the Commission under number 6/0-02-478/2019-1 of May 17, 2019, submitted by Health Institution Pharmacy BENU Beograd, with registered seat at the address 4 Kosovska St., Belgrade, Republic of Serbia, via procurator holder, attorney at law Srđana Petronijević from the Law Office Moravčević Vojnović i Partneri, 15 Dobračina St., Belgrade, on June 6, 2019, the President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquisition of control on the part of Health Institution Pharmacy BENU Beograd, with registered seat at the address 4 Kosovska St., Belgrade, Republic of Serbia, company number 17571206, over business operations of HI Pharmacy Novi Sad, with registered seat at the address 10 Narodnog fronta St., Novi Sad, Republic of Serbia, company number 8042560, relating to the provision of pharmaceutical health care services at the primary health care level in the territory of the City of Novi Sad, pursuant to the Decision on the selection of most favorable bidder JP-K-1/2019-FZD.

II IT IS ESTABLISHED that the party, Health Institution Pharmacy BENU Beograd, has made payment in the amount of XXX on May 21, 2019, into the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents a dinar-currency equivalent value of the compensation fee specified for the issuance of decisions on the approval of concentrations in summary procedure, calculated at the middle exchange rate of the National Bank of Serbia on the day of payment.
