## **DECISION**

**I** Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED**, created by acquisition of direct individual control on the part of company OTP Bank Nyrt, with registered seat at the address 16 Nádor utca, 1051 Budapest, Hungary, company registration number Cg.01-10-041585, over companies Societe Generale Banka Srbija AD Beograd, with registered seat at the address 50a/b Zorana Đinđića Blvd., Belgrade-New Belgrade, Serbia, company number 07552335, and Societe Generale Osiguranje ADO Beograd, with registered seat at the address 50a/b Zorana Đinđića Blvd., Belgrade-New Belgrade, Serbia, company number 20561211, by purchasing shares, as well as indirect control over company SoGeLease Srbija d.o.o.
