DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED**, created by acquisition of individual control on the part of company Mtel a.d. Banja Luka, company number 1-9317-00, with registered office at 2 Vuka Karadžića St., Banja Luka, Bosnia and Herzegovina, over company Financ d.o.o. Banja Luka, company number 1-12429-00, with registered office at 1c Dunavska St., Banja Luka, Bosnia and Herzegovina, by buying a share of the company’s assets.
