DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **SHALL BE APPROVED**, created by acquisition of individual control on the part of company „SITECH Sitztechnik GmbH”, with registered office at Stellfelder Strasse 46, 38442 Wolfsburg, Germany, company number HRB 100988, over company „SITECH Dongchang Automotive Seating Technology Co.” Ltd, with registered office at 1658 Fengxiang Road Baoshan, Urban Industry Zone Shanghai, 200444, People’s Republic of China, company number 91310000763972756M, by way of purchase of shares.
