DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **SHALL BE APPROVED**, created by acquisition of individual control on the part of company DTEK GRIDS B.V., with registered office at Strawinskyaan 1531, Tower B, Level 15, 1077 XX Amsterdam, the Netherlands, company registration number 73362417, over company Private Joint Stock Company „KIROVOGRADOBLENERGO“, with registered office at Studentsky Boulevard 15, City of Kropyvnytskyi, Kirovohrad Oblast, 25015 Ukraine, company registration number 23226362, by way of purchase of shares.

II IT SHALL BE ESTABLISHED that the notifying party, company DTEK GRIDS B.V., had made payment in the amount of XXX euros on May 27, 2021 into the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents the fee charged for issuing a merger clearance decision in summary procedure.
